PROGRAMS CONTINUING FROM 6th APRIL 2020


At this stage, the following programs <u>only</u> will be transitioned to our new online learning platform that is scheduled to start Monday 6th April 2020:

FEES

If you paid for Term 1 <u>and</u> your child/ren's class will continue online, your fees will be transferred towards three (3) online classes. Online classes will be available to students that have paid their Term 1 fees only. If you have not paid for Term 1, we kindly ask that you contact us to arrange your payment immediately.

If your child/ren's class will <u>not</u> be transitioning online, your Term 1 fees will be credited to Term 2. If you have paid for Terms 2, 3 and/or 4 <u>and</u> do not wish to continue, you may request a refund, however we encourage you to be patient until we have all classes either back online or face to face.



ONLINE CLASSES FEES

We understand that these are difficult times for families. We have discounted our new online learning classes to \$165 per student per term. Online classes will start in Term 2 (week starting Monday 27th April 2020).

We are excited to launch our new online learning system and ask that you take this opportunity to properly communicate and prepare your child/ren for the transition to an online platform. A device (a computer, iPad or tablet), good internet connection along with a quiet area is essential to ensuring an effective study environment. If your child/ren will be start online classes, please expect a call from our staff to discuss the new timetable soon.

If your child/ren is registered in a program that does not begin until after Ramadan, we encourage you to revise what your child/ren has learnt this term in their workbooks.
