

## EARLY LEARNERS AND FOUNDATION CLASSES

At Alfirdaus College, our aim is to ensure that your child/ren continues their Islamic learning journey and remains connected with the Quran beyond our classrooms.

Although we have temporarily ceased classes, we strive to continue to provide the knowledge, support and resources your child/ren needs to continue their studies.

We write this letter to advise parents/guardians of Early Learners and Foundation students on how they can assist their child/ren to continue their learning at home.

We kindly ask that you continue to support your child/ren's Islamic learning at home by assisting them to complete their Term 1 learning schedule for Week 8, 9 and 10. Your child/ren's learning schedule can be found at the beginning of their class workbook. We have included some helpful tips on how you can help your child revise and complete their class workbook.

### EARLY LEARNERS (Al Aqsa, Madinah and Makkah students)

- Follow the instructions that are available for each activity in your child/ren's workbook
- Use the Alfirdaus College CD to introduce and reinforce concepts
- Incorporate the Alfirdaus College flashcards with workbook activities and/or use them to create games and activities to revise previously learnt and new concepts
- Separate classwork and homework activities across two days to give your child/ren the opportunity to learn and then revise concepts

### FOUNDATION (F1-F9 students)

- Follow the instructions that are available for each activity in your child/ren's workbook
- Separate classwork and homework activities across two days to give your child/ren the opportunity to learn and then revise concepts
- Incorporate 15 minutes per day to the reading and recitation of previously learnt and new surahs in Juz Amma

- Incorporate flashcards with activities for workbooks Foundation 1-4; flashcards can be purchased from Alfirdaus College Bankstown
