Program	Updates
Early Learners	Students will be provided with an instructional letter on how to revise and complete the remaining lessons in their workbooks. All F9-12 students expected to graduate this year will be invited to join an exclusive Whatsapp group that will aid their revision at home. Our aim is to start face-to-face and/or online classes after Ramadan.
Foundation	
Bridging	Students have been transitioned to our new online learning platform using Microsoft Teams. We are expected to launch our online system on Monday 6 th April 2020 for three (3) weeks (Week 8, 9 and 10 of Term 1). The new system will include live streamed videos, pre-recorded videos, access to resources and online learning activities. Students will be encouraged to continue online classes in Term 2 (beginning Monday 27 th April 2020).

Classical Arabic	All classes have been cancelled, unless pre-arranged with the classroom teacher and their student/s.
Adults	
Tahseen Talaweh	Students have been encouraged to revise at home, following a learning schedule that has been developed by their classroom teacher. Please note, this does not apply to students who do not know how to read the Quran.
Quran Memorisation	
Graduating Students (F10-12)	Students will continue to complete Week 8, 9 and 10 of Term 1 for the next three (3) weeks from Monday 6 th April 2020. Quran lessons will be conducted via Whatsapp with head teacher and/or classroom teacher follow up. A review will be conducted at the end of Term 1 to plan the teaching strategy for Term 2.

If students require additional support, we have introduced a dedicated 'hotline' that students can call and/or message with their queries. This hotline will be overseen by Ms. Maysa'a (our Academic Assistant) and is available Monday to Friday between 10:30am – 12:30pm.
