During the Ramadan timetable:

- Monday, Thursday and Friday evening classes will move to either Saturday or Sunday. Please refer to the table on the back of this letter for specific class times.
- Classes between 9am 2:30pm, Monday to Sunday will remain on the same day and at the same time.
- Saturday morning classes will remain at 9am, and afternoon classes will be shifted to 12:30pm – 3:30pm.
- Sunday morning classes will remain from 9:30am 12:30pm. Sunday afternoon classes will run from 1pm – 4pm
- Quran memorization, Tahseen Tillawa and Tahfeeth classes will not be running during Ramadan and will start again Week 1, Term 2 (see Quran memorisation Ramadan letter for details).

Special Ramadan Program:

Boys who attend class on Friday evening will remain on the same day and time, Friday 5pm to 8pm at our Bankstown centre. This includes iftar. Your child's teacher will be in contact to provide you with more information.
