We are excited to announce our first Biannual Islamic Event Week (IEW)!

IEW is focused on delivering engaging, impactful and enjoyable Islamic Studies lessons outside the regular classroom setting. This is an initiative that will be taking place in Week 10 of Term 2 (week starting 3rd July 2023) and Week 10 of Term 4 (week starting 11th December 2023).

A core objective of IEW is to keep students motivated to learn about Allah SWT and Islam by ensuring that the learning is fun and beneficial. IEW will replace teaching classes with learning experiences! So instead of students attending class on their regular day and time at their centre, they will be required to attend their age appropriate IEW sessions.
