On behalf of the staff and teachers at Alfirdaus College, we are excited to welcome you to Term 1, 2026. Prior to the start of the term (scheduled to start the week starting 2nd February), we kindly ask that you familiarise yourself with the following information:

1. Partnership

We know a strong partnership with you will make a great difference in your child's Islamic education. Please guide and support your child's learning by ensuring that they:

- Attend class regularly and arrive on time
- Bring all necessary resources
- Complete all homework given by their teacher
- Read and/or listen to the Quran daily
- Come to class with wudu and prayer clothes for students 7+ years old
- Come to class in Islamically appropriate attire and closed shoes

2. Workbooks

Workbooks supplement your child's learning, reinforce content taught, and allow your child to revise areas of weakness. We kindly ask that you purchase your child's workbooks and other essential resources by Week 2 of Term 1.

Due to recent price rises in printing materials, the price of workbooks will be increased to \$25 inclusive of GST. We thank you in advance for your understanding.

3. Fees

A reminder, 50% of all tuition fees must be paid in Week 1 and the remainder of your fees by Week 4.

4. Class Allocations

During the first two weeks of the term, our team will be reviewing classes to ensure your child/ren is in the most appropriate class for their age and ability. We kindly ask that you be patient as we finalise your child/ren's class/es for this term.

5. Student Rules & Expectations

It is important that you and your child are aware of our student rules and expectations; these are:

- Be ready to learn
- Show respect to all

- Keep yourself and others safe
- Act and dress in an Islamic manner

6. Phone Policy

We have a strict no phones policy – phones are not to be used in class or during breaks. Students must place phones on silent and in their bags. If you would like to contact your child, please contact the centre.

7. Permission to Leave

Students 10 years old and below are not allowed to leave the centre without written parental permission. Students must be collected from the centre by an authorised adult (persons aged 18+ years old).

8. Ramadan Timetable

The 2026 Ramadan timetable will begin Week 3 this term (week starting 16th February). A letter with further information regarding your centres Ramadan timetable will be distributed in Week 1.
